In wet weather ideally in the undercroft but this may depend on booked events taking place inside the palace. • To tell the stories of the Bishop's palace to the children in an entertaining and engaging way. Primarily Bishop Jocelin and The Dragon but others too about the swans ringing the bell, Bishop Beckynton and the water. • To be flexible depending on the weather, age of children and size of group.
