Rules for Showing:

1. All entries are free.
2. Entry Forms must be completed by 9.00am on Saturday 30th May.
3. The decision of the Organisers will be final.
4. The Organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage of exhibits.
5. Exhibitors are limited to One entry in any one class.
6. Entries must be made on the entry form accompanying this schedule.
7. All entries must be brought to The Bishop's Palace on **Friday 5th June between 3.00pm and 6.00pm** except for cakes which may be brought on Saturday 6th June between 9.30am and 10.00am if you prefer.
8. No late entries will be accepted.
9. Entries must not be removed before the end of prize giving.
10. Only judges and officials are allowed to remain in the Undercroft during judging.
11. Apart from the children's classes, all sections of the schedule are open to all age groups.
12. Points and Certificates for 1st, 2nd and 3rd will be awarded in each class. All points will be totalled. The overall winner in the Adult's and the Children's classes will receive a Bishop's Palace Friends Pass (for 2 adults & unlimited children).
13. All entries must comply with the class rules.
14. Entries can be collected between 5.00pm and 6.00pm on the day.
15. All entries must be collected by Monday 8th June. Items not collected will be disposed of.
16. Every entrant will receive a named voucher for half price entry to the Palace Garden Fete.

Classes:

Section A: Cakes

- A1 **Traditional Victoria Sandwich.**
- A2 **Fruit Cake.** This can be any fruit recipe.
- A3 **Decorated Celebration Cake with a summer theme.**

Section B: Preserves

The preserves in this section can be made with any recipe. The top and label will be taken into consideration alongside the taste. Please label the flavour clearly.

- B1 **Jar of Jam**
- B2 **Jar of Marmalade**
- B3 **Jar of Chutney**

Section C: Art

- C1 **A Pencil Drawing, any subject.** No bigger than A4 including mount and frame if used
- C2 **A Landscape Picture. Subject: Local. Any medium (not photography).** No bigger than A3 including mount and frame if used
- C3 **A Photograph. Subject: Water.** Unframed and no bigger than A5 with mount if used.

Section D: Floral Art

D1 **A Miniature Arrangement.** 10 x 10 x 10cm maximum.

D2 **A Floral Table Centre.** Suitable for a special family lunch.

Section E: Handicraft

E1 **A Decorated Cushion**

E2 **A Bag made from Recycled Clothes**

Section Y: Children's Classes

The judge will assume the work displayed is the child's own handiwork.

AGE 4 - 7 YEARS

Y1 **An Animal made from Fruit or Vegetables**

Y2 **6 Fairy Cakes.** These should be presented on a plate or other base.

Y3 **A Model made from Recycled materials.** No larger than 40cm x 40cm x 40cm.

Y4 **A Drawing or Painting of a Landscape**

AGE 8 - 11 YEARS

Y5 **An Animal made from Fruit or Vegetables**

Y6 **6 Fairy Cakes.** These should be presented on a plate or other base.

Y7 **A Model made from Recycled materials.** No larger than 40cm x 40cm x 40cm.
